

**INDUSTRIAL COURT**  
**PRACTICE NOTE NO: 1 OF 2010**

**APPLICATION TO REINSTATE A CASE**

In exercise of the powers granted under section 28 of the Industrial Relations Act 1967, I hereby issue the following directions :

- 1) An application to reinstate a case which has been struck-off pursuant to section 29 (fa) of the Industrial Relations Act 1967 may be made by letter (hereinafter referred to as “the said letter”);
- 2) The applicant/first party shall state in the said letter :
  - (a) the grounds of his application; and
  - (b) the reasons for any delay in making the said application.
- 3) The respondent/opposite party may by letter reply and state his objections to the said application by the applicant/first party.
