

**INDUSTRIAL COURT**  
**PRACTICE NOTE NO: 2 OF 2010**

**APPLICATION TO AMEND PLEADINGS**

In exercise of the powers granted under section 28 of the Industrial Relations Act 1967, I hereby issue the following directions :

- 1) An application to amend a pleading pursuant to section 29(g) of the Industrial Relations Act 1967 may be made by letter (hereinafter referred to as “the said letter”).
- 2) The proposed amended statement of case, statement in reply or rejoinder shall be in red and attached to the said letter.
- 3) The applicant shall state the grounds of his application in the said letter.

- 4) The respondent may by letter reply and state his objections to the application by the applicant.
